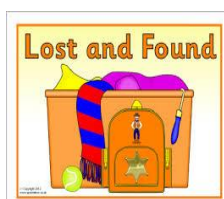
Cafeteria News

Exam Reminders:

- Morning exams begin at 9:00 am. Grade 9 and 10 exams will be 1.5 h; Grade 11 and 12 exams will be 2 h in length. These times are maximum time allotted.
- Exams will be written in regular classrooms supervised by classroom teachers.
- Early bus leaves at 11:30 am and follows the late bus route. All students must take the early bus home unless they are working directly under a teacher's supervision.
- If busses are cancelled, the missed exam day occurs on the 'inclement weather day'. The rest of the schedule stays intact. Under no circumstances will exams will be written on days that busses are cancelled.

"Paws to Relax" from Exam Stress

Stressing over exams? Try "Paws to Relax" with therapy dog Chiclet. NAEC is one of a number of LDSB Schools and Ontario Universities using animal-assisted therapy to promote emotional and physical health among students, especially during exams.

Studies have proven that interacting with dogs is as useful as conventional stress management programs for reducing anxiety and depression. Simply petting a dog lowers blood pressure, improves cardiovascular health, releases endorphins (oxytocin) that have a calming effect and diminishes overall physical pain.

Chiclet is a very sweet and gentle 5-year-old Newfoundland dog.

She has passed an intensive assessment process to become a certified Therapy Dog with St John Ambulance and has already provided her assistance in a wide variety of ways.

"Paws to Relax" will run in the Old Foyer from 8:30-9am and 11-11:30am on exam days. Please drop in and relax anytime during these sessions.
