Kingston Frontenac Public Library	The Kingston Frontenac Public Library offers programs and resources for families and children. You can access books, educational activities, and events to support your child's learning and development. The library also has resources for early literacy and a variety of materials for young readers.
The Occupational Therapy Classroom (KidsInclusive)	The OT Classroom website from KidsInclusive provides resources to support children's development, including fine motor skills, sensory regulation, and self-care. It offers activities and tools for families to assist with tasks like writing, dressing, and emotional management.
Kingston Community Health Centres (KCHC)	Kingston Community Health Centres (KCHC) provides services to support families, including health programs for children and resources for early childhood development. They offer programs designed to help families navigate health challenges and foster well-being.
Kingston Military Family Resource Centre (KMFRC)	The Military Family Resource Centre (MFRC) in Kingston offers support to military families, providing resources for child care, family care, and transition services. They offer specialized programs for children, including those related to relocation and adjusting to military life. The MFRC also supports families during deployment and reintegration.
Maltby Centre	Maltby Centre offers mental health and autism services for children and youth, including individualized care, workshops, and resources for families. They provide support for children with mental health challenges, autism, and developmental needs.
Early Expressions Preschool Speech and Language (KidsInclusive)	The Early Expressions Preschool Speech and Language program provides services for children from birth until school age , focusing on speech and language development. Parents or caregivers can make referrals if they have concerns, and the program offers support, resources, and guidance on helping children improve their communication skills.
